We met Laci in the La Porte County Jail where Sonshine facilitates the Moral Reconciliation Therapy MRT® program. Laci, here with her youngest son Leo, was arrested May 30, 2008 on four felony dealing charges. She faced 60 years in prison. At a very young age, she lost both parents, and later an older sister to cancer. Cocaine covered her pain, yet God had mercy on Laci. Laci successfully completed probation while working on a Human Services Degree from Ivy Tech Community College. She manages a large restaurant, is married and is still thanking God. Her two older sons are sober, married and fathers. And little Leo is a straight A student, very happy that “they did not take his Mommy away!” Three children spared from the cycle of addiction. We built Worthy Women Recovery Home because many “Laci’s” released, do not have the support Laci and Leo did.

We are a Christian home that provides recently incarcerated women with re-entry programs and the tools necessary to reduce recidivism rates, substance abuse addiction, and empowers them to live as positive role models for their children and in their community.



D.E. "Sonshine" Troche, Ex. Dir. of WRI, was born in Bamberg, Germany and placed in a children's home. Her Mother was hopeless. She married MSG Michael Wood(ret.) and they moved to

America in 1973. Eight years old, a foreigner and very shy, Sonshine struggled to adapt to her new environment. Depression, anger and addiction quickly took hold. Overdosing during school at age 13, her behavior spiraled out of control. She left home at 16, wasting 19 years in addiction. Sonshine surrendered to Jesus Christ in 1997. Hiring former offenders for her drywall company, she realized she had been very fortunate. An attempted murder charge was dismissed in 1995, and she knew addicts deserved a second chance. She joined the Christian Motorcyclists Association and the Breaking Through Prison Ministry Team in 2005. Two years later she started a 12 Step Bible group for local women and also became very involved in the La Porte County Drug Free Partnership in 2007. She graduated from Ivy Tech Community College in May of 2008. Sonshine became certified and began facilitating MORAL RECONATION THERAPY MRT® in the La Porte County Jail in February of 2008. Within three months she saw the need for a women's recovery home, seeing them released and rearrested over and over again. WWRH was incorporated on Veterans Day in November of 2008. Sonshine worked at the Westville Correctional Facility while growing the WRI ministry. The home was purchased on September 7, 2011 and remodeling began March of 2013. Thanks to 503 Volunteers & Contractors, and friends who donated \$320,000 in labor and material, WWRH is debt free and WE ARE OPEN!
